Diamond award for Langdon Hall

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Langdon Hall was one of only three restaurants in Ontario to receive the CAA/AAA five diamond designation.

"The CAA/AAA five/four diamond awards are the highest designation reserved for preferred restaurants and hotels that demonstrate the utmost in quality," said Tatjana Sulker, CAA South Central Ontario media and public relations specialist.

This year, three Ontario restaurants were presented with the five diamond award - Langdon Hall Dining Room & Terrace in Cambridge, Ottawa's Signatures @ Le Cordon Bleu Paris and Truffles located in the Four Seasons Hotel in Toronto. Langdon Hall also received a four diamond rating for lodging.

The diamond rating process is North America's premier hotel and restaurant rating system and is the only one that covers the United States, Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean.

Only 54 lodgings and 53 restaurants were recognized as being amongst the best in the province and honoured with the award.
